

#### **GACD SCHOLARSHIP**

The Georgia Association of Conservation Districts (GACD) is a nonprofit that works statewide to promote the conservation of natural resources. GACD, in partnership with other organizations and agencies, conducts training for the state's soil and water conservation district supervisors and educates the public on natural resources issues. Information on GACD's programs may be found at <a href="https://www.gacd.us">www.gacd.us</a>.

GACD awards an annual scholarship of \$1000 to encourage study and careers in soil and water conservation related fields. Awards will be given to students majoring in, or intending to major in, a soil and water conservation related area. Acceptable areas of study include, but are not limited to, agricultural education, agronomy, horticulture, plant pathology, and agricultural communications.

The applicant may be a graduate student, senior, junior, sophomore or freshman from Georgia at any accredited college, school, or university in the United States. Students must maintain a GPA of at least 2.75 and be financially needy. There will be no discrimination on basis of race, sex, or religion.

The Scholarship Committee will determine the recipient of the annual scholarship. The scholarship winner will be recognized at the GACD Annual Meeting in January. Disbursements will be made in two payments of \$500 paid to the student upon receipt of proof of satisfactory completion of each of two semesters of full-time academic work.

#### **GACD AUXILIARY**

The GACD Auxiliary will award an annual scholarship of \$500, which will be disbursed in one installment of \$500 upon satisfactory completion of a semester of full-time academic work.

The scholarship winner will be recognized at the GACD Annual Meeting in January.

#### **GARLAND & ANITA THOMPSON FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**

The Garland & Anita Thompson Family Scholarship was established in 2009 in memory of Mrs. Anita Burton Thompson. Mr. Garland Thompson has promoted the conservation of natural resources throughout his agribusiness career and as Chairman of the Georgia Soil and Water Conservation Commission.

Applicants may be graduate students, seniors, juniors, sophomores or freshmen from Georgia who are attending any accredited college, school, or university in the United States. One payment of \$1000 will be presented to the scholarship recipient at the GACD Annual Meeting held in January.

<sup>\*</sup> Students may submit one application to be considered for the three scholarships; individuals may receive only one award.

<sup>\*</sup> Applications and a current transcript must be received by October 15th.

## GACD CONSERVATION DISTRICT SUPERVISOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

#### **PURPOSE**

To recognize outstanding and exemplary supervisor achievements and supervisor leadership in the protection and enhancement of Georgia's soil and water resources. Provide recognition for a District Supervisor's outstanding service to GACD, NACD, and their community.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Any District Supervisor serving on a Georgia Soil and Water Conservation District Board is eligible for nomination.

#### JUDGING

The GACD President will appoint an independent panel of (3) three judges; familiar with duties and responsibilities of a Georgia Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor or request judging to be done by NACD.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA

- 1) Describe the nominee's outstanding achievements and leadership in the protection and enhancement of Georgia's Soil and Water Resources.
- 2) Provide evidence of the Supervisor's outstanding service to GACD, NACD, and their community.
- 3) Give examples of Supervisor's personal commitment to Soil and Water Conservation.

#### **DOCUMENTATION**

Documentation of the Supervisor's achievements and leadership, following the awards criteria, should be submitted on no more than (8) eight pages (front and back), 12 pt or larger font style. A maximum of (3) three letters of recommendation may be attached to the entry.

#### GACD CONSERVATION DISTRICT OF THE YEAR AWARD

#### **PURPOSE AND ELIGIBILITY**

The GACD Conservation District of the Year Award is hereby established to recognize the Conservation District in Georgia, who best plans and implements, a complete conservation program. All 40 Conservation Districts in Georgia are eligible to compete for the award.

#### **JUDGING**

The GACD President will appoint an independent panel of three (3) judges familiar with Conservation District operations to judge the entries or request judging be done by NACD.

#### **CRITERIA**

All entries will be judged using the following criteria:

- 1) District planning: Each entry should submit a copy of the Districts Annual Plan of work including the District budget. The District's Annual Report should also be submitted to allow judges an opportunity to evaluate the success of the District in implementing its Annual Plan of Work.
- 2) District Public Relations, Legislative, and Outreach Programs: Each District entry should submit a collection of articles, photos, brochures, videos and other supporting data, which shows the success of the District's public relations, legislative, and outreach programs. Legislative contacts, soil stewardship activities, District demonstrations and field days, Conservationist of the Year programs, outreach programs, and radio and TV programs and other public relations efforts should be documented.
- 3) Conservation Education: Each entry should submit documentation of the district's efforts toward a comprehensive conservation education program. Information concerning teacher workshops, student workshops, outdoor education facilities, conservation curriculum, and other conservation education activities should be well documented.
- 4) District's Assistance to Constituents: District entries should document districts efforts in working with landowners and land users on Natural Resource issues. The District's efforts in assisting landowners and land users applying Best Management Practices in Agricultural and Urban lands should be documented.

#### Documentation

Documentation of the District's work, based on the judging criteria, should be placed in a three (3) ring binder; should be limited to 50 pages (front and back), divided into sections according to standard criteria.

The deadline for entries this year will be December 31st
